Minutes of the Community Council meeting held in the Millennium Hall, Llanfallteg on **Wednesday 18 June 2008** at 7pm

1. **Apologies for absence** – County Councillor Susan Allen
2. **Declarations of interest** – None
3. **Co-option** – Mrs Eve Edwards was voted onto the Council. **Clerk to inform CCC Statutory Services Manager**
4. **Correspondence received**
 - a. **CCC – Footpaths & Bridleways – Maintenance Programme 08/09 – It was decided to carry on with the project started last year. DK to provide list of work to do and forward this to CCC - Eirian James**
 - b. **WWAMH Carms – Re: compliments and complaints guidance and procedures are changing workshop. Noted**
5. **Planning applications for action**
 - a. **W/19196 Old School House, Llanfallteg West, change of use to residential dwelling. No problem in change of use. Concerns were expressed regarding level of extension roof line in relation to existing building. Splay onto road – Highways should be consulted on this. There is no mains sewerage in the village and private alternatives would need to be sought. Clerk to action**
6. **Internal Auditor – Mr Peter Icke agreed to continue as Auditor**
7. **Taf Myrddin meeting – Various topics were discussed including Post Office closures which the council will comment on in writing. GC to action**
8. **Local Development Plan (Response date 18 July 08 – GC). It was decided that to determine what is appropriate in terms of development in the village a flyer would go out to the public. Residents' views would then be sought on Fete Day. DK to action. To be c/f to next meeting**
9. **NHS meeting (Response date 25 June 08) – Clive Mortlock attended the meeting and reported that fundamental changes were to be made and will pen a response. Clerk to action**
10. **Fire Service – A written response was made by Clive Mortlock. Clerk to action**
11. **Traffic Calming – Gideon Carpenter informed the meeting that surveyors had marked spray lines for road painting at village boundaries. Following discussion with CCC planing to reduce road levels and subsequent resurfacing would not be carried out until next year at the earliest. Core samples to be taken by CCC. A site visit to be organised for autumn time. GC to follow up**
12. **Keep Wales Tidy – It was decided to ask for funding to provide 2 more litter bins in the village and to request removal of invasive weeds/plants. Clerk to action**
13. **Any other bus iness – DK informed the council that the Community Police Woman had visited the village and hopes to attend the next meeting. Clerk to action**
