1 An exhibition - led by history society. Open from Aug Bank Holiday until 10th Sept at least. (Subject to stewarding arrangements)

2 Construct a working model of the station as was about then in "N" gauge (1 in 150th of full size - this would be about 9 ft long x 18 inches wide as viewed from north looking towards the station) - several have shown interest in building this, and we have already acquired a loco and some wagons of the type used through here. The CA agree that it could become a full time exhibit in a "glass case" fixed up on the wall in the main room.
