OPEN CLASSES

FLOWERS

- A1 Roses - 3 stems
- A2 3 hydrangeas any type but all the same
- A3 Flowering shrub in a pot not over 18" in diameter
- A4 Vase of perennial flowers

FRUIT & NUTS

- B1 3 Apples
- B2 3 Pears
- B3 A display of seasonal fruits and berries max. diameter 18"

VEGETABLES

- C1 A harvest festival collection, no bigger than 18" across.
- C2 3 courgettes
- C3 3 parsnips
- C4 6 runner beans
- C5 3 sweet corn
- C6 A plate of salad vegetables about 12" in diameter
- C7 2 of any other vegetable

COOKING & PRESERVES

- D1 A sliced fruit or nut cake made with local fruit or nuts
- D2 A jar of pickles
- D3 A jar of chutney
- D4 6 Welsh cakes.

WINE & BEER

- E1 A bottle of home brewed wine
- E2 A bottle of home brewed beer (submit 2)

FARM PRODUCE

- F1 A jar of Honey set or clear
- F2 A bale of hay any size or shape
- F3 A 250gm pat of butter
- F4 A small home made cheese
- F5 6 Hen's Eggs
- F6 3 Duck eggs

CHILDREN'S CLASSES - U7

FLOWERS

- G1 A sunflower in a pot or a vase
- G2 A vase of wild autumn fruits and flowers
- G3 3 flowers of the same colour in a vase

VEGETABLES

- H1 A vegetable grown by the entrant
- H2 An animal made from vegetables

COOKING

- J1 4 home made biscuits

CHILDREN'S CLASSES 7 - 11

FLOWERS

- K1 A pattern made with daisies
- K2 A bunch of wild autumn flowers attractively displayed.

CRAFT

- K3 A welly boot decorated any way you choose e.g. paint, flowers

VEGETABLES

- L1 Any collection of three vegetables, the same or different, grown by the entrant.
- L2 A bowl of blackberries.

COOKING & PRESERVES

- M1 A cake made by the entrant which uses an ingredient from the garden or hedgerow e.g. apple cake, blackberry muffin.
- M2 A pot of chutney or jam.
- M3 Bread baked to look interesting or unusual, judged on appearance.

GENERAL SHOW RULES AND ARRANGEMENTS

1. All exhibits must be the property of the exhibitor and grown or made by the exhibitor.
2. All exhibits must be staged between 6pm and 8pm on Friday September 18th or between 9am and 10.30pm on Saturday September 19th. Judging will begin at 11am. Doors will be open to the public at 2pm when the show opens. Prizes will be presented at 4pm.
3. All consumable exhibits and any other exhibits donated will be auctioned after the prizes are presented. All other exhibits should be removed before 5pm.
4. The Entry Fee for open classes is 50p and for children up to age 16, entry is free.
5. First prize in each class will be £2 including children's classes. There will be no other prizes except for special cups and trophies. There will be certificates for 1st, 2nd and 3rd place in each class.
6. The organisers take no responsibility for accidents, damage or loss to persons or property during the day.
7. Judges decisions are final.
