Digital photograph on the theme of 'A Perfect Day'.
JPEG Format ONLY - Note DIGITAL only.

C COOKERY

- C1 A fruit cake
- C2 Four welsh cakes
- C3 Four decorated cupcakes, judged on the cake and the decoration.
- C4 A Victoria sandwich cake
- C5 A sweet pastry item any pastry but must be homemade!

D PRESERVES

- D1 A jar of jam
- D2 A jar of chutney

E EGGS

- E1 Six hens' eggs

F DRINKS

- F1 A homemade alcoholic drink
- F2 A homemade non alcoholic drink

G FRUIT, VEGETABLES AND FLOWERS

- G1 A vase of home grown flowers
- G2 A tray of home grown vegetables, maximum 50cm x 50cm
- G3 A tray of home grown fruit (including rhubarb), max. 50cm x 50cm
- G4 Two different vegetables three of each.

- H1 'Someone you know'

- I1 Make and decorate three cupcakes
- I2 A painting of your family
- I3 A picture of a dragon any medium

J AGES 8 TO 11

- J1 Make and decorate three biscuits

K AGES 12 TO 16

- K1 Make a sponge sandwich cake
- K2 A printed photograph of a pet taken by you
- K3 A picture of a dragon any medium

Llanfallteg Show Rules 2015

- Entries for the show should be brought to the Millennium Hall 6 until 8 pm. on Friday July 17th and 9 until 10 am. Saturday July 18th.
- Digital photograph entries to be delivered during the same periods on a USB stick. A cup will be awarded for the judges selection – competition 1. Show visitors will also vote on their top photographs – competition 2. Best of these will be displayed on the community web site and also in the Hall for up to a year.
The entry fee is 50p for all entries into the open classes, except photography digital which will be £1.
Entries in to the Children's classes are free.
- All entries will be given a number that must be attached to them. No responsibility can be taken for any items entered in to the show; anything entered is at your own risk.
- If you wish to donate any entry, please tell one of the stewards.
- Judging will commence at 11 am. The decision of the judge is final.
- The prizes are £2 for first place all Classes.
- The show will be open to the public at 2 pm. when the fête opens. Prizes can be collected from 4 pm. Cups and prize money can also be collected at 4 pm. Prize money not collected by 5.30 pm. will be considered to have been donated to the fête.
- All entries must be removed from the hall by 5 pm. on Saturday July 18th.

- Cup for Best Photographic Entry
